Basic Bible Facts about Jesus Christ

John 14:6 Jesus Christ said, "No one comes to the Father [God], but by Me." 1Timothy 2:5 There is only "One Mediator ... the Man Christ Jesus."

Don't be fooled - "Antichrist" is HERE NOW!

- 1 John 2:18,19 "Even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. They went out from us." These "antichrists" are false apostles that arise from within the Christian Church.
- 1 John 2:22 If anyone "denies that Jesus is the Christ, he is antichrist, that denies the Father and the Son." Antichrists subtly deny the Father (God) and Jesus Christ, our One Mediator, the only way to the Father.
- 1 John 4:1-4 The "spirit of antichrist" is now "already in the world." It denys that "Jesus Christ is come in the flesh." Because Jesus is fully human, we need only "one mediator ... the man Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 2:5.
- **2 John 7** "Many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. *This is a deceiver and an antichrist.*"
- 1 John 2:26; 4:4-6 Christians are to "overcome" the subtleties of antichrist.

The Antichrist in 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4

- 2:1 Jesus is "coming" to "gather" His children.
- 2:3 Before this "coming" and "gathering," there must "come a falling away first and that man of sin be revealed [KJV]." "That man of sin" is the same as the "little horn" with "eyes like the eyes of a man" (Daniel 7:8), "the beast" (Rev. 13:1) and "that woman Jezebel" (Rev. 2:20). All of these symbolic expressions refer to a system of deception which will ultimately deny "the Man Christ Jesus." 1 Tim. 2:5. Antichrist is "the son of perdition." In John 17:12, Jesus Christ applied this phrase to Judas, who was a clever, yet false apostle of Jesus Christ! This would be the nature of Antichrist!
- 2:4 Antichrist will "as God sit in the temple of God" which is the Church. See 1 Corinthians 1:2; 3:16; Eph. 2:21. He will "sit" in a position of Supreme Authority which actually replaces the Supreme Authority of Jesus Christ. Mark 16:19. He would "exalt himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped ... [cleverly] showing [not 'saying'] himself that he is God."

All of the Reformation Protestants and the Translators of the King James Bible applied the above words to the Roman Church. The Pope "sits" in the Church claiming Supreme Authority. This Church has introduced many mediators - Popes, priests, saints, Mary - which is actually a subtle denial of "the Father and the Son." 1 John 2:22. The Holy Bible says there is only "One Mediator ... the Man Christ Jesus." 1 Timothy 2:5. No one comes to "the Father" but through Christ. John 14:6. Yet the head of the Roman Church "sits as God" by defining and enforcing traditions which contradict the Bible.

- **2 John 7** "Many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. *This is a deceiver and an antichrist.*"
- 1 John 2:26; 4:4-6 Christians are to "overcome" the subtleties of antichrist.

The Antichrist in 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4

- 2:1 Jesus is "coming" to "gather" His children.
- 2:3 Before this "coming" and "gathering," there must "come a falling away first and that man of sin be revealed [KJV]." "That man of sin" is the same as the "little horn" with "eyes like the eyes of a man" (Daniel 7:8), "the beast" (Rev. 13:1) and "that woman Jezebel" (Rev. 2:20). All of these symbolic expressions refer to a system of deception which will ultimately deny "the Man Christ Jesus." 1 Tim. 2:5. Antichrist is "the son of perdition." In John 17:12, Jesus Christ applied this phrase to Judas, who was a clever, yet false apostle of Jesus Christ! This would be the nature of Antichrist!
- 2:4 Antichrist will "as God sit in the temple of God" which is the Church. See 1 Corinthians 1:2; 3:16; Eph. 2:21. He will "sit" in a position of Supreme Authority which actually replaces the Supreme Authority of Jesus Christ. Mark 16:19. He would "exalt himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped ... [cleverly] showing [not 'saying'] himself that he is God."

All of the Reformation Protestants and the Translators of the King James Bible applied the above words to the Roman Church. The Pope "sits" in the Church claiming Supreme Authority.
