1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 Those who are not "caught up" will experience "sudden destruction" during this great "day of the Lord."

Zephaniah 1:2,3,14-18 Global destruction comes during "the day of the Lord."

Joel 1:15 "The day of the Lord" results in "a destruction from the Almighty."

Jer 25:30-33 "The slain of the Lord ... from one end of the earth to the other."

Luke 17:26-30 As the fire destroyed Sodom and the flood "destroyed them all ... even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed." In other words, the earth will be depopulated when Jesus returns!
