

1000 Years and the Lake of Fire

The Beginning of the 1000 Years

Revelation 20:4,6 The "*first resurrection*" of believers *begins* the 1000 years.

1 Thessalonians 4:16,17 The "dead in Christ shall rise *first*" when Jesus returns.

All true believers will then be "caught up ... to meet the Lord in the air."

1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 Those who are not "caught up" will experience "sudden destruction" during this great "day of the Lord."

Zephaniah 1:2,3,14-18 Global destruction comes during "the day of the Lord."

Joel 1:15 "The day of the Lord" results in "a destruction from the Almighty."

Jer. 25:30-33 "The slain of the Lord ... from one end of the earth to the other."

Luke 17:26-30 As the fire destroyed Sodom and the flood "*destroyed them all ... even thus shall it be* in the day when the Son of man is revealed." In other words, *the earth will be depopulated when Jesus returns!*

Revelation 6:14-16 Global destruction is coming.

Revelation 16:17-21 A "great earthquake" will occur. Cities around the world crumble, islands sink and mountains are moved out of their places.

Revelation 19:17,18 The birds "eat ... *the flesh of all men.*"

During the 1000 Years

John 14:1-3 Jesus has taken His people to the New Jerusalem in heaven.

Revelation 20:4 Judgment will be given to the saints.

1 Corinthians 6:2,3 The saints judge the wicked world and fallen angels.

Jeremiah 4:23-26 There is "*no man*" left upon a desolate earth.

Jeremiah 25:30-33 The slain cover the earth.

Revelation 20:1-3 Satan will be bound by a "chain" of circumstances (there are no people left on earth) in the "bottomless pit." The "pit" represents the grave. Isaiah 14:11,15; 24:17-22. The earth will be like a huge cemetery!

The End of the 1000 Years

Revelation 20:5 "The rest of the dead" (*all the lost*) will live "again" at the end of the 1000 years.

Isaiah 24:17-22 All of the dead who have been "in the pit (the grave) ... shut up in the prison (during the 1000 years) ... *shall be visited.*"

John 5:29 Jesus calls this "*the resurrection of damnation.*"

Revelation 20:7 Satan will be "loosed" *because the lost will be alive again.*

Revelation 20:8 Satan will deceive and gather all the lost for a final battle.

Rev. 20:9 They surround the New Jerusalem (it will come down - Rev. 3:12).

Rev. 20:11-13 The final Judgment of Satan and all the resurrected wicked.

Revelation 20:9 Then "fire came down from God ... and devoured them."

Revelation 20:14,15 All the lost will be "cast into the lake of fire." *

Revelation 21:1,4,5 There will be a new earth. There will be no more pain, crying, sorrow or death, "for the former things are passed away."
