The Unpardonable Sin is against the Holy Spirit

Matthew 12:24,25,31,32 Jesus warned the Pharisees (very religious people) about the Unpardonable Sin against the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 12:31 *"The blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven."*

In Order to Avoid the Unpardonable Sin Against the Holy Spirit, We should Understand the Work of the Holy Spirit

John 16:14:17; 15:26; 16:13 "The Spirit of truth" will "guide you into all truth."

Jesus is the Truth. John 14:6. The Word is Truth. John 17:17. His Law is Truth. Psalm 119:142. Thus the Holy Spirit is working to "guide you" into a deeper knowledge of Jesus Christ, His Truth, His Word, and His Law.

John 16:8 The Holy Spirit comes to "*convict the world of sin.*" Sin is breaking the Law. 1 John 3:4; Romans 3:20; 7:7,12.

Romans 8:4 "That the righteous requirements of the law might be fulfilled in us who walk ... after the Spirit." *Thus the Spirit leads us to keep the Law.*

Galatians 5:22,23 The result of following the Spirit is "love, joy, peace ..."
